During this time, she wanted to reignite a love for reading with some children and adults as well as contribute to normalizing

As a result, she began writing an illustrated series showcasing vibrant lead characters of color that each have different gifts that connect to a profession. "Becoming a children's author was not something I planned for," she admits. "I didn't have control over the desire to write; it was just something in me. I trusted my instincts and moved forward."

Like her clients, the move to authorship is one that introduced hurdles of time and fear. It was a project that required her to adjust her daily schedule, seek out writing groups and mentors, and overcome self-doubt, but the purpose she found persuaded her to move forward into the uncertainty of a new venture.

"Developing your gifts is not just about personal success—there are people who are benefactors of our gifts and achievements," she explains. "There are children waiting to see the books I was writing, excited to learn about a new career that they can see themselves in as

well as hopefully develop a love for reading.

"I want people to feel that they can do something with the professional desires they consider in private," she concludes. "We should all experience what pursuing our gifts has to offer."
